



# School Uniform Policy

At TLC Private School we have a compulsory school uniform. We believe that a commitment to uniformity in dress is consistent with a commitment to study and a clear statement that our students sign up to our organisation. We would like to think uniform is worn with pride!

We respond to the climate by relaxing the uniform in the warmer months. The uniform includes the following:

## **Kindergarten and Primary Students (up to Year 6)**

Black shoes

Black socks for boys

White socks/grey tights for girls

Grey shorts/trousers/skirt

Royal blue polo shirt with logo

Sweater (optional)

As an alternative to the polo shirt and skirt, girls may wear the embroidered gingham dress.

## **Secondary (Years 7 to 11)**

Black shoes

Black socks for boys

Natural colour tights for girls

Grey trousers/skirt

Blue blouse (girls) or shirt (boys)

Scarf for girls (compulsory winter wear, optional in summer)

Tie for boys (compulsory winter wear, optional in summer)

Blazer (compulsory for winter wear, optional in summer). Orders to be placed in September.

Sweater (optional)

## **Sixth Form (Years 12 and 13)**

As for secondary but with a white blouse (girls) or white shirt (boys)

## **PE Kit (All students)**

Royal blue tee shirt

Black shorts

Socks (optional)

Trainers

From September 2015 winter over-garments will be available. Consultation will be carried out before the school commits to a particular style.

## **Swimming**

From September 2015, for safety reasons, students with long hair will be required to wear a swimming cap.

These will be available in the School Shop.
